Iridescent Paint

1 Available in nine bright colours, Iridescent Paints are a set of water based paints that give a slight hue change when viewed from different angles. There are several different methods of application, here's one idea.

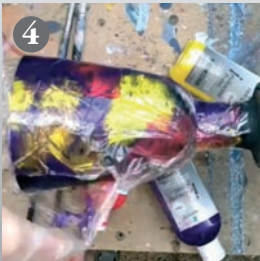
2 Seal the wood first using a sealer; Ebonising Lacquer works well with these paints but it is not essential to have a black background. Here the paints are being applied by brush.

3 A mixture of Purple, Red and Yellow have been applied randomly by brush in a haphazard pattern.

4 Whilst the paints are still wet, cover with cling film and gently move the paints around to create a swirling pattern. Repeat if needed, always using a fresh piece of cling film each time.

5 Allow the paints to dry and overcoat with Acrylic Gloss Lacquer to really bring out the brightness of the colours.
